Monroe County is seeking a dependable and skilled **Equipment Operator** to support the maintenance and repair of county roadways. This position plays a vital role in ensuring safe and well-maintained roads for the community through the operation of various types of equipment and performance of manual labor duties.

Key Responsibilities

- Perform roadway repairs, including patching roads
- Maintain right-of-ways by cutting grass and clearing debris
- Load and transport rock, gravel, and other materials
- Remove fallen trees and obstructions from roadways
- Repair and replace street signs and mailboxes
- Flag and direct traffic in work zones
- Perform minor equipment maintenance and repairs as needed

Minimum Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED required
- At least one (1) year of related experience in equipment operation or road maintenance
- Valid driver's license (State of Georgia)
- **Commercial Driver's License (CDL), Class A or B required**

- Ability to follow instructions and work independently with minimal supervision
