

NOTICE OF ELECTION

TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF MONROE COUNTY, GEORGIA:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 48-8-111(b), O.C.G.A. § 21-2-540 and other applicable election laws, on May 19, 2026, an election will be held at the regular polling places in all the election districts of Monroe County, Georgia (the "County"), at which time there will be submitted to the qualified voters of the County for their determination the question of whether a 1 percent county special floating local option sales and use tax (the "FLOST") shall be imposed on all sales and uses in the special district of Monroe County for a period of time not to exceed 20 calendar quarters for the raising of approximately \$50,000,000 exclusively used to reduce property taxes.

The ballots to be used at said election shall have written or printed thereon substantially the following:

- ( ) Yes Shall a special one percent (1%) sales and use tax be imposed for five (5) years within the special district of
- ( ) No Monroe County with the proceeds use exclusively to reduce property taxes imposed by Monroe County and the City of Forsyth?

The several places for holding said election shall be at the regular and established voting precincts of the election districts of the County, and the polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the date fixed for the election.

The last day to register to vote is April 20, 2026.

Those residents of the County qualified to vote at said election shall be determined in all respects in accordance with the election laws of the State of Georgia.

This notice is given pursuant to a resolution of the Monroe County Board of Elections and Registration.
