Subject: Culloden Recreation Park

On March 17, 2026, Jimmy Pierson came before the Board of Commissioners asking for assistance with the Culloden Recreation Park. Below is the overview from the previous memorandum:

Eddie has given an overview of the discussion as follows: "The recreation park in Culloden still belongs to the county as best as they can tell. They have put in excess of \$30,000 into the park in recent years to improve it. They have come to the point that they need some assistance to add new playground equipment and functioning restrooms and concessions. They will ask the county for whatever assistance they may be able to provide. The recreation area in Culloden serves residents in the far southwest corner of our county who would have to travel many miles to use the recreation department in Forsyth. While they are an organized community, they don't have the resources of some of our other outlying areas. Bolingbroke has businesses to pull from, High Falls has the state park, and Juliette has the tourist revenue."

The amount of the request that has been mentioned in discussions is around \$40,000.00.
