Unfortunately, and for the time being, after school care through the Boys and Girls Club is not available. We do not have a timetable for when services will be restored. We will do our best to update you on this matter as soon as possible.

Dear Club Parents and Guardians,

We are writing to you today with an important update regarding afterschool programming at all Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Georgia's Club (BGCCG) sites for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year. We understand how much you rely on our Clubs for a safe, enriching environment for your children, and we deeply value the trust you place in Us.

It is with a heavy heart that we must inform you that after much review and deliberation, BGCCG's board of directors has made the difficult decision to temporarily suspend all operations, effective July 20, 2026, for an initial period of 90 days due to severe operational and financial challenges.

During this 90-day period, interim CEO Brian Flemming and the board will conduct a thorough assessment of BGCCG's financial standings and operations to fully evaluate the organization's long-term viability.

We recognize that this news may create significant challenges for your family once the school year begins. Please know that we are committed to supporting you through this transition. Our team is available to help you explore alternative afterschool resources that meet your needs. We are profoundly grateful to our staff, donors, and the Central Georgia community for their decades of partnership and dedication to our youth.

We are profoundly grateful for the opportunity to have served your children and our community and will continue to update you going forward. Thank you for your understanding and continued support.

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
